20 external agencies attended our Pathway & Outcomes Event on the 6th February 2023. Like last year, the transition team explored destination data as well as referring to the provider access legislation and SEND local offer website. As a result, we invited various destination providers post 16/19 as well as Health, Adult Social Care, Parent link, Travel training and Transition & Preparation for Adulthood Service. Two of our learners from post 16 supported our event and welcomed the external agencies as well parents.


"The two young men (work experience I believe) were very good when signing me in – very helpful, they also worked hard with hospitality throughout the day!"

Next Steps

- 1. Transition team/Extended Leaders and staff to explore means of increasing parental engagement from year 8 onwards re: the transition process. Signposting through parental structured conversations, highlighting support to our parents/learners via the local offer and raising awareness of support and options out there.
- 2. Transition team to explore bespoke events for specific curriculum pathways and invite ex parents and/or learners to share their journey with current parents/learners in order to facilitate a smoother transition as well as making an informed decision whilst raising aspirations.
- 3. Following feedback and evaluation of the event, transition team to arrange coffee mornings with learners and parents re: travel training, training providers and supported internships.
- 4. Transition team to continue to meet legal requirements re: provider access legislation, sustain partnership links with external agencies in order for our learners/parents to have a smoother transition post Calthorpe.
