

Pathway and Outcomes Day (November 2025)

This year we had an extremely successful and well attended Pathways and Outcomes event, with parents from years 7-13 in attendance.

The transitions team explored destination data as well as referring to the provider access legislation and SEND local offer website. As a result, we invited various destination providers post 16/19 as well as Health, Adult Social Care, Travel training and Transition & Preparation for Adulthood Service.

Learners who attended the event had research booklets to complete at the event, which supported engagement between learners and the providers in attendance. Learners were able to ask key questions at the event and then refer back to their booklets as a way of helping to make informed choices about their future.
